

List of FAQs with answers, during admission enquiry-

1. What are the age criteria for entry level admission?
Answer: - The rule for age appropriate admission in classes is 4+ added to the class should equal the age of the child. E.g. 4+ added to class 1 = 5, the correct age of for class 1.
2. School's boarding facility starts from which class?
**Answer: - The School's boarding facility begins right from Nursery particularly in case of parents where the same is needed such as (i) Parents located in small towns with not so good educational facility
(ii) Both working parents with lesser time at hand
(iii) Parents working abroad
(iv) Single parents**
3. Is the school is a Co-Ed school?
Answer:-Yes, it's a Co-Ed school. The coeducational school provides a balanced environment for children of both genders. It sensitises them to the needs of each other and boys and girls compete, collaborate and aspire better. Higher standards of discipline are set by appreciating the permissible codes of conduct in each other's company with understanding and respect.
4. School Follow the curriculum of which particular board?
Answer:- The school is affiliated to CBSE-Central Board of Secondary Education a national Board. We follow the national Curriculum Framework and now NEP 2020. We are also accredited with NIOS-National Institute for Open Schooling for more flexible educational needs. Both the Boards are recognized internationally.
5. Do you have hostel for girls?
Answer:-Yes we have safe, secured, separate hostel for girls with professional lady wardens and warders. Our lady Principal, Dr Shakuntla S Jaiman herself stays on campus in a residence which is located in proximity to the girls hostel and takes keen personal interest in its functioning.
6. Is school campus is safe for girls?
Answer: - The school campus is absolutely safe with 70% of our well qualified and dedicated female and male staff staying on campus.
7. What is the area of the school?
Answer: - The school is spread in 15 acres of green, clean and serene environs of South Delhi.
8. When the school was established?
Answer: - The school was established in April 1986 and has an unparalleled legacy of excellence in education blazing a trail of very successful, well settled/accomplished alumni.
9. Where the school is situated /located?
Answer: - The school is located in South Delhi. It is '17 KMs' from Indira Gandhi International Airport, '23 KMs' from New Delhi Railway Station and '7 KMs' from nearest (Chattarpur and Qutub) metro stations.
10. What is the staff length?
Answer: - 55+ teaching staff and 80+ non-teaching staff.

11. How many students are currently enrolled in total?
Answer:-Presently we have 1000+ students of which 40% are in Boarding and rest in Long Hour Day Boarding/Weekend Home Boarding.
12. Mostly students are from which areas?
Answer: Students are from all across India and abroad. We offer an excellent blend of cultures to a diverse population of students who enrich the environment.
13. What is family back ground of currently enrolled students?
Answer: - Most of the students belong to professionals and government 'A' grade service class. Our clientele is educated and cultured.
14. Will there be the entrance test to get admission?
Answer: - Yes, there is an entrance test for admission. It is also to ascertain the level and potential of the student seeking admission.
15. What about results of previous sessions?
Answer: - Our results have been outstanding. CSKM follows a Nil failure policy from Nursery to XII and put up each child to face the board exams. We have 100% pass in class X and near 100% pass in XII with 30-40 percent students securing A1 and A2 grades in all subjects. We aim for the weakest students to achieve a minimum of 50%.
16. Are all teachers experienced/educated according to the requirements?
Answer:-The teaching staff is highly qualified and experienced and includes a number of PHDs and Gold Medalists. They are dedicated to students and have taught in various well known coaching institutes in their early career being fully capable to guide.
17. What about medical facility?
Answer: - We have 16-bedded Medical room equipped with all first aid and necessary equipment. An MBBS doctor and two trained resident nurses are available round the clock. We also have tie ups with nearby hospitals like Fortis, Max etc. for adequate and prompt specialised treatment of our students.
18. How is the quality of food?
Answer: - Food is the 'Prasad' of God. It is cooked fresh in every meal on principles of nutrition to enable sustained energy for the students. All staff including Principal, Directors, guests and visitors partake of the same food.
19. The food will be Vegetarian or Non-Vegetarian?
Answer: - Both Vegetarian and Non-Vegetarian food options are available and students sit separately for the option they select.
20. The list of sports activities.
Answer: - List of sports activities- Football, Basketball, Cricket, Lawn Tennis, Table Tennis, Badminton and many more.
21. Do you have swimming pool?
Answer: - Yes. Its length is 25 meters and it has 6 lanes. There's also a splash pool for the youngest students.
22. Does school participated in interstate competitions?

Answer: - Yes, we are the inter-zone champions and every year individual students are then selected for district, state and national level teams We have many national winners like Pallav Rousha (Yoga), Arjun Khatri and Ritwik (Basket ball) Priyanka Priyadarshi (swimming), etc.

23. Do you plan educational tours?

Answer: - Yes we plan educational and adventure tours.

24. Do you have tie up with Aakash, Byju's or Narayana for competitive exams?

Answer: - Yes, we used to have tie-ups with premier coaching institutes but during the pandemic it has not been possible

25. Is there any routine career counseling sessions for senior students?

Answer: - Routine career counseling sessions are held each year with expert agencies EPCP- Eminent Person Contact Programme, for student interactions with eminent persons from all walks of life to enable them to expand their vision and aspire high are also conducted.

26. What about CCTV coverage?

Answer: - 145+ CCTV cameras are placed on campus. The recordings are received daily for any critical incident and reported to authorities. Parents can see the CCTV footage if necessary by proper permission from the Principal.

27. Do you provide CCTV access to parents?

Answer: - No it is not parent's job.

28. What about hostel's lay out-how many students stay in one room?

Answer: - Hostel lay out is different for different groups. Ranges from 2-6 students in a room senior to junior.

29. Is English speaking compulsory?

Answer: - We encourage students to speak in English for fluency but we also inspire respect for correct Hindi speaking which is our national language.

30. Mobile phone is allowed to the students?

Answer: - No, the wardens are given a non smart phone in every dorm for students to remain in touch with parents.

31. Are students allowed to have any electronic gadget like laptop or tablet along with them in hostel rooms?

Answer: - No, students are not allowed keep any electronic gadget.

32. What about RO water system?

Answer: - RO water is available at all drinking water points.

33. How does school manage the study of boarder students after school time?

Answer:-Supervised evening preparatory classes and remedial guidance by subject teachers.

34. What is the student teacher ratio?

**Answer: - 1:15 in Nursery and KG
1:30 in senior classes.**

35. Is school environment is safe during COVID period?

Answer: - School environment is absolutely safe during COVID. The CAB is always being followed.

36. Is school staff vaccinated?

Answer: - Yes all school staff members are fully vaccinated.

37. Is there a Library in the school?

Answer: - Yes there is a huge Library for senior and junior students.

38. Are there smart classes?

Answer: - Yes, school has a tie up with Byju's classes.

39. Is each child given an opportunity to participate in school functions etc.?

Answer: - Yes. 100 % participation is there.
