Method to make sprouts:

Wash and soak the pulses for at least five to six hours. Strain the excess water. Wrap the pulses in a clean damp cloth and keep it in a container. Cover it partially. Leave it undisturbed in a warm and dark place till they sprout. Watch the pulses after 6 –7 hours. You will find them sprouted.
